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# Uppingham School Easter Revision Course

## Sunday 9th – Thursday 13th April 2017

Uppingham is delighted to offer five days intensive tutoring for students about to sit their IGCSE exams in **Biology, Chemistry, Physics or Maths**.

The ideal preparation for this important stage in every student's life, subjects will be taught by a team of highly qualified and experienced teachers, including teachers from Uppingham School.

### Course Content

Students will receive three hours tutored revision per day for each of their chosen subjects. This will include reviewing core areas of the syllabus and improving understanding of key facts in order to boost confidence and motivate each student. Study skills will be covered, including organising study time, taking effective notes, writing concise, technical answers and organising exam time effectively. Tutors will recommend different revision techniques, and students will practise past papers under exam conditions. They will be given some practice questions each evening to prepare for the following day.

Class sizes will be a maximum of 10 to ensure that every student is given individual attention and directed tuition.

### Subjects and Exam Boards

Tuition will be offered for Edexcel or CIE IGCSE Biology, Chemistry, Physics and Maths. Students studying for GCSE exams in any of these subjects are welcome on the course, since nearly all the topic areas covered are common to IGCSE and GCSE, but only IGCSE past questions will be used as examples and in testing. Students studying for Double Award IGCSE Science are welcome on any of the courses since there is an 80% overlap with the individual sciences – eg 80% of the Edexcel IGCSE Chemistry course is also in the Edexcel IGCSE Double Award Science course.

Two past papers and model answers will be issued to each student at the end of each course, alongside all the revision materials provided by the tutor.

## Schedule

Residential students will arrive on the evening of Saturday 8th April.

Non-residential students will arrive on Sunday morning.

Residential students should choose TWO subjects so that they are studying in both the mornings and afternoons; non-residential students may choose to study either one or two subjects, and are welcome to study quietly in the Science Centre during the other half of the day should they only be doing one subject.

Three hours of tuition each day for five days will be offered in the morning for Subject 1 and the afternoon for Subject 2.

Residential students will have an opportunity to take part in sporting activities at Uppingham School Sports Centre at the end of each day.

There will be supervised study time each evening after dinner in the boarding houses.

## Accommodation

Residential students will be allocated a single study bedroom in one of Uppingham School's boarding houses. Some bedrooms benefit from ensuite facilities; these will be allocated on a first come basis. Meals are freshly prepared and will be served in the boarding house dining room. A dedicated Houseparent will be resident in the boarding house with the students to ensure their safety and wellbeing, and to oversee mealtimes and recreational and study periods.

## Cost

### Residential £950

Includes full board accommodation for five nights, six hours tuition per day covering two subjects, supervised prep time and use of Uppingham School Sports Centre.

### Non-Residential £375 per subject

Includes three hours tuition per day, either morning or afternoon.

# Terms and Conditions

Uppingham School's aim for its Easter Revision Course is to provide a stimulating working environment for examination preparation. To achieve this, and for the welfare of all pupils and staff, the following guidelines must be adhered to:

1. All registrations must be accompanied by fully completed application form and £250 non-refundable deposit per subject. Upon receipt, the booking will be officially confirmed to you via e-mail.
2. Full fees for the course must be paid in advance of tuition, no later than Friday 24th March.
3. Late applications will be considered only if there are unfilled places on the course.
4. We reserve the right to cancel any course if under-subscribed. In such circumstances, the student may elect to study an alternative course (if places are available) or obtain a full refund of fees paid. We will always attempt to do this with as much notice as possible. Fees will not be refunded for any other reason.
5. Non-residential students studying ONE subject only might be allocated a morning or an afternoon session. Regrettably this cannot be requested in advance. We will endeavour to inform all parents of course timings at least 2 weeks prior to the courses beginning, once the timetabling has been completed.
6. We make every effort to match tuition with individual needs, but students must realise that a revision course, however intensive, cannot be expected to cover all aspects of all specifications.
7. Uppingham School shall not be liable for loss or damage to personal property or injury to persons however caused, other than that where negligence on the part of the School is proved.
8. Drugs and alcoholic beverages may not be brought onto or consumed within the boarding houses or any other part of the school campus. Failure to abide by this rule will result in immediate removal of the student.
9. Smoking is not permitted in any of Uppingham School's buildings or on Uppingham School grounds.
10. Uppingham School reserves the right to remove any student if in our view, the behaviour of the student is detrimental to the smooth running of the course or the studies of other students.
11. Parents or guardians will be charged for any damage to property caused by malice or neglect.
12. Any student who needs to leave Uppingham School at any time for any reason during the course must obtain permission from the Course Director. Residential students must obtain permission from the Head of Pastoral Care.
13. No residential student may be out of the Boarding House after the evening registration.
14. Students may not invite guests into the School at any time during the course.
15. Uppingham Summer School or a representative may photograph or film courses and participants for marketing and promotional purposes. By agreeing to the terms and conditions, consent will be presumed unless Uppingham Summer School is notified in writing in advance of your child attending the course.
