- Choir

They will also take part in interactive creative workshops focussing on vocal/body percussion, movement and group composition.

The experience includes performing in front of an audience of family and friends in a number of concerts over the week, including the gala end-of-course concert on Friday afternoon.

Children must bring their own instrument (except percussionists), should be at least Grade 1 standard and be comfortable reading music.

Course Director Ben Wingfield leads a team of top-rate music professionals and young musical assistants, bringing together a wealth of educational expertise and experience in nurturing young musicians.

An experienced pastoral team will take care of the children overnight and when they are not busy with their musical activities. The varied evening programme includes various sporting activities, bowling, quizzes, film nights and an end-of-course disco.
